Collective Worship Assembly

This week's collective worship was led by the Year 5 Collective Worship Leaders and was about communication, with special reference to British Sign Language, a way to communicate with hearing impaired people. A school in Bristol is offering it's students the opportunity to study a GCSE in BSL from 2025. The Collective Worship Leaders presented the PowerPoint to the rest of the school and collected thoughts, ideas about whether it was a good idea and also about other ways in which people communicate. There was a lot of positive feedback from the other children, who agreed that learning some BSL would be a good idea.

Science Assembly and Workshops

On Thursday we had a visit from Ben, a member of the SAW Trust, who presented his show called 'To the Moon and Back' in a science led assembly. The SAW Trust are an organisation who aim to bring science into everyday lives and develop new ways of stimulating creativity, exploration and learning. They are running this in conjunction with the Norwich Science Festival.

Ben performed his show for the whole school and told everyone lots of facts about the Earth and the Moon, including that the Earth rotates at 460 m/s, it took Saturn V 4 days, 6 hours and 45 minutes to reach the Moon, the Moon is a quarter size of the Earth, the temperature on the Moon can vary from 127°C in the daytime to -130°C in the night and that Saturn V was split into 3 different parts for it's voyage to the Moon.
