In the afternoon they walked down the road to the village hall where they were able to meet Dave and his Wonder Dome. The Wonder Dome is an inflatable planetarium that the children could go inside and look up at the ceiling where Dave projected all kinds of wonderful images and animations about space for the children to see and he took us on a tour of the Milky Way and beyond. All of the children had an amazing time and they really enjoyed the animated rollercoaster tour of the planets at the end!
